PERSONAL EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST 2010

Please Note:

- **All equipment must be clearly named.**
- **No radios, torches, money, chewing gum or jewellery.**
- **No responsibility will be taken for watches or cameras.**
- **No food (lollies etc) is to be taken to camp**
- **No aerosol cans are permitted – Roll on repellents / deodorants only**

- Packed lunch and drink for Monday 29th March
- Pack or large bag
- Back/Day pack (Suitable for hike) and drink bottle
- 5 plastic (shopping) bags for storing wet / used gear
- Sleeping bag and blanket
- Pillow and pillow case
- Sheet (to cover camp mattress)
- Pyjamas – 1 pair
- Teddy Bear or stuffed cuddly toy (compulsory for boys as well as girls)
- Togs and 3 towels (one towel to be suitable for the beach)
- Wet weather gear (rain coats / water proof jackets etc)
- Flannel & toiletries – Soap / toothbrush / tooth paste / shampoo / roll on deodorant
- Sunhat, sunscreen, insect repellent
- 2 tea towels (clearly named as these are put into a pool of towels and returned at the end of camp)
- Warm clothing – jerseys, swandris, sweatshirts etc
- 4 - 5 shorts, T-Shirts, underwear, socks
- 2 – 3 pairs long pants
- 2 pairs comfortable shoes (shoes must be worn at all times in the dining room / one pair must be suitable for hiking)
- 1 pair of jandals
- Hankies or tissues
- Reading Book
- Camp Booklet, pencil, pen and rubber
- 6 pegs

Please send only old clothing, as it will get dirty. Every effort will be made to locate missing clothing but ultimate responsibility for the care of all clothing is that of the student.
